



- Binta Idodo appeared personally and by her attorneys of record.
- Tony Idodo appeared by his attorneys of record, but failed to personally appear.

Regardless of who carries the burden of proof on the relief sought in the Motion to Modify, the Court finds good cause to deny the Motion to Modify, and it is in the best interest of the Receivership for the Receiver (and his designees and agents) to continue as the sole person in control of SMA Group, Incorporated. Therefore, the Motion to Modify is DENIED. To the extent the September 1, 2017 *Order Appointing Receiver and to Compel Discovery* (“Receivership Order”) requires clarification, modification or amplification, the Court finds that the Receivership Order grants, empowers and vests the Receiver, Andrew Korn, with authority to take control of SMA Group, Incorporated, and solely manage the business and affairs SMA Group, Incorporated, operating it using his business judgment. To the extent the Receivership Order did not previously permit the Receiver to do so, it is now modified to do so.

Any person or entity who fails to recognize or obey the authority of the Receiver (and his designees and agents) as the exclusive person to act on behalf of SMA Group, Incorporated, may be held in contempt or otherwise sanctioned for interfering with core functions of the Court (*e.g.* the enforcement of orders and judgments).
